APPLICATION DEADLINE:

- ✓ Your application must be sent, complete with your transcript, questions and essay to the AEA Educational Foundation by April 1, 2017.
- ✓ Applications received without completed information will not be considered.
- ✓ Transcripts sent separate from applications will not be accepted.
- ✓ Winners will be announced in May 2017. Scholarship monies will be disbursed July 2017.

- Scholarship monies cannot be used for any type of flight training or air traffic control programs.
- Scholarships will be made payable to the recipient and his/her school, and must be endorsed by both parties.
- Scholarship monies will not be disbursed until the student has enrolled per the scholarship sponsor's criteria (verified by the school's business office).
- All scholarships are merit based with restrictions.
- Scholarship applicants must have at least a cumulative 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- All scholarship monies must be used for the 2017-18 school year.
