"Basic Wiring & Avionics Installation" is for currently employed repair station personnel, A&P mechanics and individuals who are interested in improving or acquiring the skills necessary to perform avionics installations in general aviation aircraft. The hands-on installation lab includes Garmin GNS 430, GMA 340 and GI 106A.

- what is involved and how to plan/manage an avionics installation;
- common installation considerations, procedures, methods and techniques;
- antenna installation procedures;
- transmission line fabrication and precautions;
- what tools are required and how to use them when performing the mechanical and electrical installation of a given avionics package; and
- the required documentation and relevant regulatory guidance.
