### APPLICATION PROCEDURES

**A complete application will consist of the following:**

1. Letter of recommendation from current employer.
2. A brief essay written by the applicant outlining how he or she would benefit in their job by attending the 61<sup>st</sup> AEA International Convention and Trade Show.

Candidates will be judged based on their essay and employer recommendation.

Applications will be assessed by an expert panel and winners will be selected by the AEA Educational Foundation Scholarship Committee.

1. AEA will cover transportation and hotel costs for the award winner to attend the AEA International Convention and Trade Show in Las Vegas, Nev. – March 26-29, 2018. *Note: Winner's employer will be responsible for remaining costs.*
