

Aircraft Security

When not attended, prevent the unauthorized operation of all large aircraft capable of flight, by using one or more of the means listed in paragraphs (b)(2)(i) through (iv) of this section. In these examples, a key, if used, must only be available to an individual authorized by the repair station who has successfully undergone a check as described in paragraph (b)(3) of this section.

- (i) Block the path of the aircraft such that it cannot be moved, and control the vehicle key if a vehicle is used to block the path.
- (ii) Park the aircraft in a locked hangar and control the key to the hangar.
- (iii) Move stairs away from the aircraft and shut and, if feasible, lock all cabin and/or cargo doors, and control the key.
- (iv) Other means approved in writing by TSA.
