



# Transport Standards Staff Organization




## Transport Airplane Directorate Responsibilities

- → Regulations and Policy
- → FAA validation of non-US manufactured transport airplanes
- → Design Approvals
- Manufacturing, Production and Airworthiness Approvals

#### **Transport Standards Staff Functions**

- → Participate in government/industry transport airplane rulemaking committees.
- → Manage and coordinate the TAD airworthiness directive (AD) program for transport airplanes for transport category airplanes certified under part 25 regulations on a worldwide basis.
- → Develop and issue part 25 regulations, associated advisory circulars and guidance, exemptions, and special conditions.
- → Certification and continued operational safety of import transport airplanes.
- Standardize application of regulations across all transport airplane projects

# **Aircraft Certification Office Functions**

- Determine aircraft/component designs meet design standards
- Issue Type/Amended Type/Supplemental Type Certificates
- Issue Technical Standard Order (TSO) and Parts Manufacturer Approval (PMA) authorizations
- > Monitor continued operational safety of aircraft
- Make safety determinations-support development of Airworthiness Directives
- > Provide oversight of Designees and Delegations
- Make compliance findings to other authority's certification basis
